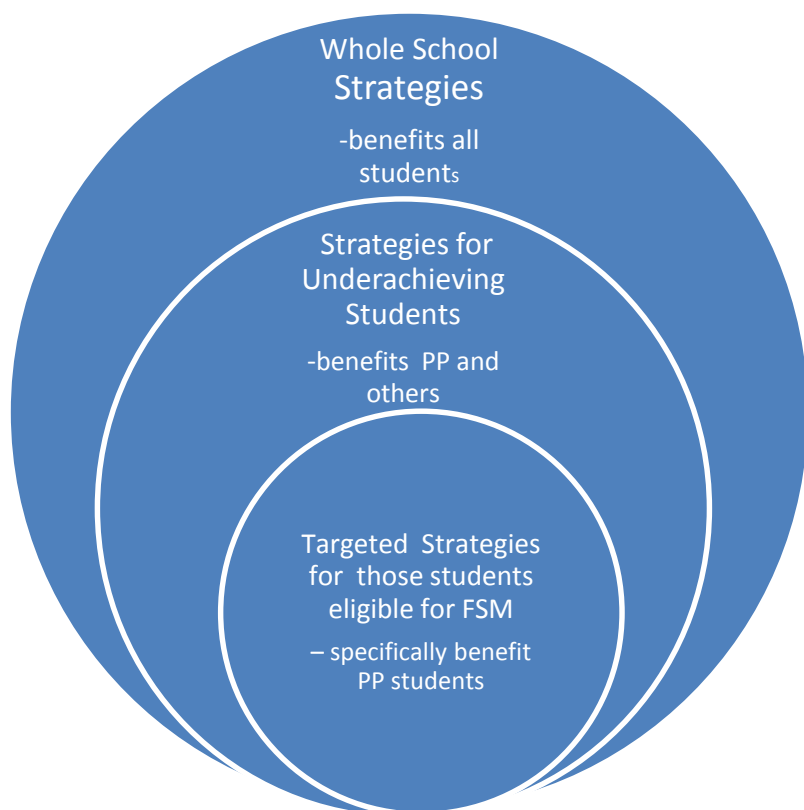

Improving Numeracy & Literacy	Breakfast Reading Club every morning provides breakfast for pupils to ensure they are prepared for the day as well as literacy and reading support. RAIL project Year 6, level 6 classes provided at King's Reading age testing, monitoring and support
RWCM focus on School Dev Plan and literacy /numeracy group established	Literacy Group, DF & two Literacy coordinators employed. One to one and one to two or small groups at KS3 for literacy and numeracy support Numeracy Club/Literacy club & competitions Kindle Corner
Intervention	Mentoring White British boys Project Additional ICT support for learning such as Kindle Fire with downloads and access to lap tops. Inclusion strategies	<p>Extracurricular support to ensure participation by pupil premium pupils eg music lessons and equipment and sports equipment/school sports wear.</p> <p>Visits/Residential visits/GT visits, theatre, etc including visits abroad are 50% funded</p> <p>Curriculum support and provision of alternative curriculum where needed eg.Off-site learning such as Forest School and Young Fire Fighters, ECT,TLG, BSS at St Mary's and Occupational College course expenses.</p> <p>Work and College placements</p> <p>School Police Officer support – a shared Safer Schools Police officer to work with pupils and parents</p>
Pastoral and Financial Support	<p>Uniform and school equipment support, these can be loaned temporarily from a stock kept in school or be provided by the school when needed long term i.e. School Blazer and Tie, School shoes, PE kit, Art books, Aprons, Ingredients for Food etc The School provides Design &Technology material and other consumables for PP pupils where needed, so that they are not disadvantaged in the learning and making of products.</p> <p>Replacement Planners provided</p>
