To new Students and Parents/Carers,

The school Library/Learning Resource Centre is situated on the ground floor with its entrance just along the corridor from main reception. It is easily accessible to all members of the school community.

Students may use the facilities during break and lunchtime, when they will be able to borrow and exchange library books or use the computers for schoolwork.

All Year 7 students are automatically members of the library and can start to borrow books straightaway. All students have an allowance of one book to start with. Books are usually loaned for two school weeks (not main summer holidays) and should be returned on time and in good condition. We hope that parents/carers will encourage and support their child's library book borrowing and continue to take an active interest in the books their child borrows throughout their time at The King's School. *However, please note that books returned late will incur a fine and damaged or lost items will be charged at replacement cost.*

Due to the wide range of reading abilities/ages in school please remember that most books are not actively censored although efforts are made to encourage students to read appropriately. We hope that all students will make use of the huge range of books available to them in the school library for their personal reading and to help with their school subjects. We are sure they will find something suitable as new titles across a wide range of subjects and genres are added to stock throughout the year.

Meanwhile, we look forward to meeting our new Year 7 students and working with them throughout their time at King's.
