Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s)

I am writing to confirm that we are delighted to hear that your child has been accepted for a place at The King's School and very much look forward to welcoming them here in September.

In total, 210 students were accepted to attend our School and the work has already begun to ensure that the transition from Primary to Secondary Schools runs as smoothly as possible. Our Year Achievement Leader, Mr Leeson, is currently arranging transition activities, which will occur throughout the summer. All of these activities are aimed at all the students looking and thinking positively towards their time at The King's School.

Throughout June, Mr Leeson will visit all of our main Primary Feeder Schools and try to get to know the students. On this visit students will be given a 'Welcome Pack' containing lots of information about starting at King's. We have also arranged an 'Intake Day' on **Wednesday 05 July 2017**, whereby the students will be introduced to their new Form Group and attend some sample lessons. On this day your child should arrive at the School Hall at King's for 8.50am and the day will finish at 3.15pm. On the same day you will also have the opportunity to attend a 'Parents Information Evening' and to speak to the Form Tutor. Full details about these events will follow shortly.

This year we have accepted students from 21 different Primary Schools and there is a possibility that your child is the only student from their existing School who has been accepted at The King's School. If this is the case, we will do everything possible to make them feel welcome. We will be able to arrange for them to be included in any planned transition activity which may take place in a school close to where you live.

I am sure that you have many questions regarding the School and hopefully over the summer all of these questions will be answered. If you have any particular queries which you would like to discuss prior to the Intake Day, please do not hesitate to contact Mr Leeson.

Once again, we look forward to your child joining our School in September and to working in partnership with you to achieve 'Success for All'.
