The Learning Resource Centre is home to a large selection of fiction and non-fiction books as well as a full class of computers. There is a homework club in the LRC every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday for one hour after school, where students can revise, use computers, print or study.

Loans

Loans are initially set at one per student, which may be increased at the discretion of the LRC Manager, and must be returned to the issue desk by the date stamped on the loan label. Late returns will incur a fine at current rates. All lost and damaged books are charged at full retail cost.

Fiction Books

New books are added to stock throughout the year, keeping up with popular series as well as new authors. The selection covers a range of genres as well as reading abilities.

Non-Fiction Books

The range of non-fiction books offers supporting material to subjects which are taught in school as well as offering a varied selection of general interest titles.

Computers

Are available for school work and have internet access. Computer game playing is not permitted in the LRC.

Printing

Two laser printers - one colour and one monochrome are available in the IT area. Students are allowed to print during break times for school work, homework, coursework and projects; personal printing is not allowed.

LRC Club

The LRC is open from 3.15pm until 4.15pm on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday afternoons for homework and coursework.

Code of Conduct

Students may use the LRC during social times, but must adhere to the LRC code of conduct. This consists of the following rules:

- No food or drink in the LRC at any time.
- Computer use is for school work only and not gaming or personal use.
- Noise level must be low and sensible behaviour is expected at all times.
- Mobile phones must not be used in the LRC, the computers are available for internet-based work.
