Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s)

We are writing to make you aware of some forthcoming activities, for which we would welcome your support.

The Year 10 trial examinations will take place over a two-week period, starting on Monday 18 June. A copy of the examination schedule is attached, together with a summary of the work students would be expected to undertake over half term in order to begin preparing for their examinations.

We would like to build on the positive work ethic demonstrated by the Year Group in the lead up to, and during, their recent GCSE examinations. We were really pleased with how well they prepared and we are aiming to help them prepare for their GCSEs in Year 11. We are proposing to have an Examination Focus Month, commencing straight after half term, where (for two weeks) students will be engaged in various revision activities leading up to the start of the examinations on Monday 18 June. In the week commencing Monday 04 June we will be asking students to pick five subjects and come up with a target in each, followed by some extension revision tasks and "market place revision" delivered by Subject Teams on Wednesday 13 and Thursday 14 June from 3.15pm until 4.30pm.

We understand and appreciate the support that parents and carers give to enable students to achieve and we would appreciate your support in engaging your child in the revision activities as much as possible. These examination results will be included in the end of year report.
